ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF THE

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AZALEA HOUSE SCHOOL, INC.

These articles of incorporation are signed and acknowledged by the incorporators for the purpose of forming a non-profit corporation under the provisions of the Alabama Non-Profit Corporation Act, as follows:

ARTICLE ONE

The name of the corporation is AZALEA HOUSE SCHOOL, INC.

ARTICLE TWO

The purpose or purposes of this corporation are as follows:

- (a) To establish and incorporate a non-profit Montessori Society for the benefit of all people in Huntsville and Madison County, Alabama who are interested in the Montessori Method of instruction.
- (b) To own, operate, manage and conduct a school or schools to teach the Montessori Method to school age and preschool age children.
- (c) To maintain and apply the standards and principles established by Dr. Maria Montessori during her distinguished career in education and vocational guidance work.
- (d) To receive and administer funds for the aforesaid purposes and for no other prupose, and to that end to take and hold by contract, agreement, bequest, devise, gift, purchase, lease, either absolutely or in trust for such objects and purposes or any of them any property real, personal or mixed, without limitations as to amount or value, except such limitations if any, as may be imposed by law; to sell, convey, and dispose of any such property and to deal with such property for any of the aforementioned purposes, without limitation, except such limitations, if any, as may be contained in the instrument under which such property is received; and to exercise any, all and every power for which a non-profit corporation organized under the provisions of the Alabama Non-Profit Corporation Act, all for the public welfare can be authorized to exercise, but not any other power. No part of the

activities of this corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation.

ARTICLE THREE

The location of the corporation is in the City of Huntsville in the County of Madison, and State of Alabama. The post office address of the registered office in Alabama is: 3514 Wildwood Drive, Huntsville, Alabama. The name of its registered agent at said address is Anne Lieb.

ARTICLE FOUR

Said corporation is organized on a non-stock basis. Said corporation is to be financed under the following general plan: by contributions to it of funds and property absolutely or in trust and by grants received and contracts and agreements entered into for its purposes as herein stated and for no other purpose.

ARTICLE FIVE

All Officers of the corporation heretofore described shall be members of the Board of Directors.
