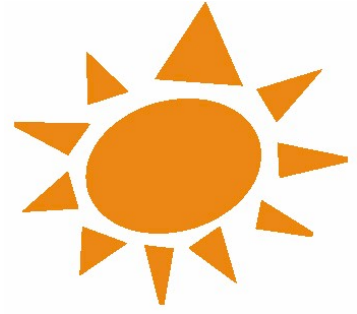


Summer at MSH
